SCHEDULING ORDER

On February 8, 2024, the petitioners, Appalachian Power Company and Wheeling Power Company, by counsel Anne C. Blankenship and William C. Porth, Robinson & McElwee PLLC; and Keith D. Fisher, American Electric Power Service Corporation, timely perfected an appeal from a final order of the Public Service Commission (Commission) entered on January 9, 2024 (Case Nos. 21-0339-E-ENEC, 22-0393-D-ENEC, and 23-0377-E-ENEC), with the filing of their petitioners' brief and appendix. The petitioners also filed a motion to exceed the page limit for the petitioners' brief on the same date. The motion has been reviewed and it is ordered that the motion to exceed the page limit is granted.

The appeal has been placed on the docket as 24-75, and all filings related to this appeal must refer to this Court's docket number and use the case caption set forth in this order.

On March 5, 2024, the Commission filed the sealed portions of the record of the proceedings had before it and on March 19, 2024, the Commission filed the remainder of the record of the proceedings had before it. The Court acknowledges receipt of both.

On March 22, 2024, the Commission, by counsel Jessica M. Lane and Susan M. Stewart, Public Service Commission of West Virginia, filed a motion to supplement the record, along with

the supplement. The motion has been reviewed. The motion to supplement is granted and the supplement is ordered filed.

The Commission, by counsel, filed its statement of reasons on March 25, 2024.

Due to the filing of the statement of reasons prior to entry of a scheduling order, the deadline for filing any motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief and amicus curiae brief in support of the Commission is extended to April 15, 2024.

Any reply brief deemed necessary may be filed by the petitioners on or before May 6, 2024

This matter is scheduled for oral argument on Wednesday, September 4, 2024, in accordance with West Virginia Code § 24-5-1 and Rule 19 of the Rules of Appellate Procedure. The Clerk of Court will, on a later date, provide counsel with a Notice of Argument under Rule 19(b), containing further information on the time of oral argument.
